Books for Babies is a national literacy program that acquaints parents of newborns with the important role they play in the development of their children.

Parents are presented with a Books for Babies kit containing a board book for baby, baby's first library card, and a variety of brochures and reading tips and early literacy information from nationally-recognized educational organizations.

The Friends of the Mansfield Public library supplies the library with kits to be given to each of the teen mothers at the local school district. Parents help their babies become more literate by reading to their babies and by becoming regular library users themselves.

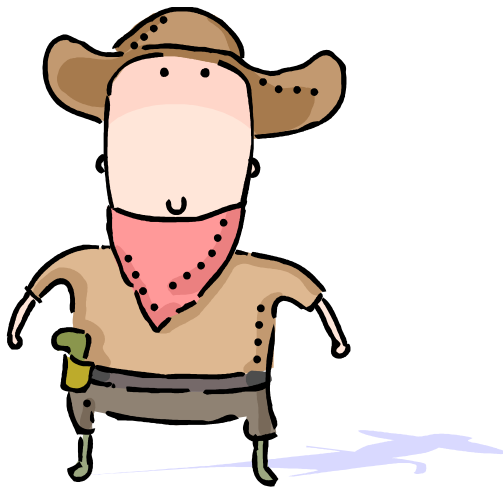
Come help decorate the library tree!
